When a retiree or dependent is enrolled in Medicare Parts A & B, they can enroll in any Blue Medicare Advantage plan. However, if the Medicare member enrolls in an Advantage plan and another family member is not enrolled in Medicare Parts A & B, the other family member will have to enroll in one of the BCBSKC Plans to be covered on a City sponsored health plan. If all family members are enrolled in Medicare Parts A & B, they must enroll in the same health plan. If one member is enrolled in a Blue Medicare Advantage plan and the other is enrolled in a BCBSKC plan, and the BCBSKC member turns age 65 and enrolls in Medicare Parts A & B, both members must then enroll in the same plan, either the Blue Medicare Advantage plan or the BCBSKC plan.

*Please note. Blue Medicare Advantage premiums will be increased in the event a retiree or dependent are subject to a Medicare late enrollment penalty.
